May and June... means

we'll be celebrating

Mother's Day and Father's

Day, and remembering all of
the love and sacrifices

Mothers and Fathers make for their children. We can think of God's love and sacrifices for us, His children, in the same way.

While we recognize the Trinity as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, we remember that Jesus also referred to Himself in motherly terms as well. For example, when Jesus mourns the fact that His own children, Israel, in His holy city, Jerusalem, have rejected Him, He says, "O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, killing the prophets and stoning those who are sent to you! How often would I have gathered your children together as a hen gathers her brood under her wings, and you would not!" (Matthew 23:37) Jesus compares God's love for His children to a mother hen who instinctively, and fiercely, wants to gather and defend her brood. And imagine the heartache the mother hen would feel if her chicks reject her and won't let her do so!

We've also hear God speak of Himself "Like an eagle that stirs up its nest, that flutters over its young. spreading out its wings, catching them, bearing them on its pinions" (Deuteronomy 32:11) This imagery of a mother eagle protecting her young by "hovering over" them is also used to describe the Holy Spirit in Genesis "the Spirit of God was "hovering over" the face of the waters." (Genesis 1:2) And that same verb is also used to describe the Passover. When telling them about the Passover, God says to Moses and Aaron, "The blood shall be a sign for you, upon the houses where you are; and when I see the blood, I will pass over you, and no plague shall fall upon you to destroy you, when I smite the land of Egypt." (Exodus 12:13) This is often interpreted as God "skipping over" those houses with the blood on the lintel and doorposts and, in effect, sparing them

from death. However, another interpretation is that God will "hover over" those houses, like a mother eagle protects her young by "hovering over" them with her wings. In that case, God isn't "skipping over" those houses; God is "hovering over" them, and not allowing death to harm them. In the same way, when Jesus goes to the cross, we can see Him spreading His wings, like a mother bird, on the cross, and "hovering over" us, to protect us from the powers of sin and death, and His willingness to die, rather than let any harm or evil befall us.

As we celebrate Mother's Day and Father's Day, let's also remember <u>all</u> the ways that God has loved us and sacrificed Himself for us, His children, in ways that are like both a loving father and mother. And knowing that God's love goes beyond anything we can possibly imagine. Thanks be to God!
