In the month of May, we'll be celebrating 2 persons receiving their Holy Baptism, and 2 persons graduating from high

school. Baptism sounds like a beginning. Graduation sounds like an ending. But, as I'm sure you know, that's not entirely true. God claims us as His children before we reach the Baptismal Font, and graduation from high school is often the beginning of further education.

One interesting question is... what is the highest level a Christian can achieve in the Lutheran Church? Is it Confirmation, where we affirm and claim the Baptismal promises our parents made for us so long ago? Is it going to seminary and becoming a Lutheran Pastor? Or how about being elected as the Bishop of our Synod, or even as our churchwide Bishop?

One of our retired Bishops asked me this question when I was in seminary, and I didn't know the answer. And he simply replied, "The highest level a Christian can achieve in the Lutheran Church is the Baptized Christian".

In Holy Baptism, God the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit claims us as His very own child, delivers us from sin and death, and raises us to new life in Jesus Christ. We are also united with all the baptized into the one body of Christ, anointed with the gift of the Holy Spirit, and joined in God's mission for the life of the world.

If God does all that in Holy Baptism, what else could we possibly achieve?! Baptism isn't just a simple rite we perform to welcome someone into the church family as a "junior member". Baptism is a sign of God's love, grace, mercy, and forgiveness that lasts with us through our whole life, until our Baptism is completed in our earthly death, where God's promise of eternal life with Him is then realized.

As we journey together in a life of faith in Jesus, let's remember that we're all equal in the eyes of God, as His children, and we're all called to join together as the body of Christ to love our neighbors and tell them the good news of Jesus, so that they, too, can join us as God's children in the world. Thanks be to God for that amazing gift!
