Just the other day, I watched as my neighbors' 2 sons headed to the bus stop for their first day back at elementary school. I remember when our daughter Lindsay was that age, and what the first day of school was like. We shared a special breakfast together, she put on a special new outfit, and we always took her picture in front of the fireplace before she left for the bus. And it was a joyful reminder that she was growing up. That "first day of school" morning was always a special day.

One of the beautiful gifts God gives us is the gift of a new day... every day. They may not all "feel" special, but they are. Martin Luther reminds us that as we wake up each morning, we should make the sign of the cross on our foreheads and remember that we have been baptized... chosen and claimed by God Himself as one of His Beloved Children. After our morning prayer, Luther says we should "Then go to your work with joy, singing a hymn". At the end of the day, we again remind ourselves of our baptism, say our evening prayer, and then "go to sleep promptly and cheerfully". Martin Luther reminds us that every day is a special day, a gift from God that we shouldn't take for granted, or get bogged down in the worries of the day. Instead, we can take the time to remind ourselves of who we are (Beloved Children of God), give thanks to God for the gift of this day, and ask God to protect, guide, and lead us in every moment of the day. And to go into our daily work and later return to sleep both cheerfully and joyfully. What a way to make each day a special gift from God! Thanks be to God for all that He so abundantly provides!

Pumpkin Prayer

In *The Pumpkin Patch Parable*, Liz Curtis Higgs uses kid-friendly analogies for the Christian life. Many parents now use a Pumpkin Prayer while carving jack-o-lanterns in October. What a great reminder about everything God has done for us! While cutting off the pumpkin top, pray, "Lord, open my mind so I can learn new things about you." (See Proverbs 1:7.) While removing the seeds and pulp, pray, "Remove the things in my life that don't please you. Forgive the wrong things I do and help me forgive others." (See Matthew 6:14-15.) While making eyes, pray, "Open my eyes to see the beauty you've made in the world around me." (See Psalm 104:24.) While making the nose, pray, "I'm sorry for the times I've turned up my nose at your many gifts." (See James 1:17.) While making the mouth, pray, "Let everything I say please you." (See Psalm 19:14.) While lighting the candle, pray, "Lord, help me shine your light to others through the things I do." (See Matthew 5:16.) Display your carved pumpkins as examples of how God's love transforms us into new creations. (See 2 Corinthians 5:17.)

JULY 15, 2024

Devotions were led by Fred Oestreicher President Bob Wolff called the meeting to order at 7:34 pm.

In attendance: Bob Wolff, Ryan Winslow, Fred Oestreicher, Pastor Paul, Lisa Pegg, Greg Paterno, and Sharon Marks. Also in attendance was Financial Secretary Eliot Moore and Treasurer Eldora Crist. **Motion** made by Fred Oestreicher to approve the agenda. Second by Ryan Winslow. Motion carried. **Motion** made by Bob Wolff to approve the Secretary's Minutes from June 10 meeting. Second by Lisa Pegg. Motion carried. **Motion** made by Sharon Marks to approve the Treasurer's Report. Second by Greg Paterno. Motion carried.

Pastor's Report: Pastor attended the SWPA Synod Assembly from June 13-15 and served as the chairperson of the elections committee. In 2025 there will be a bishop's election at Synod Assembly. Pastor will be heavily involved in that process at next year's meeting. He presided at the funeral of John Rosendahl (husband of member Glenda Rosendahl) at St. Matthias on June 24. He presided at the wedding of Christian Huey and Sherry Venersky at St. Matthias on June 21. Pastor did a home visit with Ronnie Kauffman on July 3. He was on vacation from July 4-12. Pastor Paul continues to serve as Interim Pastor at Good Sheperd Lutheran Church in Greensburg approximately 5 hour per week.

Communications: A parishioner would like to provide the funding for replacing the carpet runners in the sanctuary and possibly the hallways. By consensus, council approved for him/her to move forward with the project. **Concerns:** None

Motion carried. **Motion** made by Fred Oestreicher to approve the Secretary's Minutes from July 15 meeting. Second by Greg Paterno. Motion carried. **Motion** made by Bob Wolff to accept the Treasurer's Report. Second by Fred Oestreicher. Motion carried.

Pastor's Report: Pastor Paul presided at the funeral for Joe Welling on July 17 at Kepple-Graft Funeral Home. He attended a Property Committee meeting on July 12, and made home visits with Alycefaye Stewart and Vickie Georges. He visited with Virginia Turner at St. Anne's Home as well as the Brookdale Retirement Community. A nursing home visit was made with Don Ohr and a hospital visit with Ronnie Kauffman. Pastor presided at a funeral for a non-member at Mason-Gelder Funeral Home and presided at the Blessing of the Animals on July 31. He attended a Synod Resource Center Advisory Board meeting at the Synod office and a Synod Assembly Review meeting via Zoom. Pastor continues to serve as Interim Pastor at Good Shepard Lutheran Church in Greensburg for approximately 5 hours per week.

Communications: The church office received a fraudulent email which appeared to be from Chuck Vita. The email was obviously a fraud. 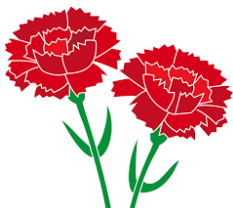
