As we partner with several other churches in this program, St. Matthias provides meals for approximately 30 children at Maxwell Elementary School on a regular basis (as we're assigned) throughout the school year. Your enthusiastic generosity of food supplies continue to help many children in need to not have to worry about what they'll eat on the weekends.

It's always heartbreaking to think of **any** child that might **not** have new school clothes, a new backpack, new school supplies, or enough food to eat. Thanks be to God for programs like these, and the organizations that organize and facilitate them (like

Thrivent Financial and our Hempfield Area School District). It's heartwarming to know that even in times of desperate need for so many, God provides opportunities to reach out with God's love to our neighbors in need, and especially to our children. ## St. Matthias Lutheran Church Council Minutes – 7/5/2022

The July 2022 Council meeting was held via a Zoom Conference call. Voting Council members Fred Oestreicher, Bob Wolff, Lisa Pegg, Norb Georges, and Pastor Paul were in attendance. Ryan Winslow was unable to attend. Our Treasurer, Eldora Crist, was able to attend. Our Financial Secretary, Eliot Moore, was able to attend. Fred Oestreicher led the devotions at 8:02pm. Council President Fred Oestreicher called the meeting to Order at 8:04pm. Fred Oestreicher made a motion to accept the Council agenda, as presented. Motion seconded by Norb Georges. Motion carried. Fred Oestreicher made a motion to accept the minutes from the June 13 Council meeting, as presented. Motion seconded by Bob Wolff. Motion carried. Eldora Crist, Treasurer, presented the June Treasurer's report. Fred Oestreicher made a motion to accept the June Treasurer's report. Motion seconded by Lisa Pegg. Motion carried.

Pastor Paul presented his report for **June**. He attended meetings for: the monthly Synod meeting for Pastors and Deacons and a Synod Assembly Committee Planning meeting. He chaired the Elections Committee again at this year's SWPA Synod Assembly from June 16-18 (via Zoom call). He made nursing home visits with Lillian Reno, Jean Kauffman, and Virginia Turner. He presided at the funeral for a non-member. As previously mentioned to Council, he'll be on vacation from July 8<sup>th</sup> through the 15<sup>th</sup>, as well as July 19<sup>th</sup> through the 21<sup>st</sup> for his annual prostate cancer checkup. Pastor Paul continues to serve as Interim Pastor at Good Shepherd Lutheran Church in Greensburg for approximately 5 hours per week.

### **Committee Reports:**

**Worship and Music:** Committee met on June 29 to plan for the fall. On July 3, we celebrated the Baptism of Gavin Reid Wolff, the grandson of Bob and Mary Lou Wolff. In the month of August, our Organist and Choir Director, Chuck Vita, will be offering the "request a hymn" program again, and during the month of July, the congregation will be invited to submit hymn requests for August. We also look forward to having 3 baptisms on August 14<sup>th</sup>! **Christian Education and Youth:** Our 3 Confirmation students were confirmed on Pentecost Sunday, June 5. **Stewardship:** No new information. **Fellowship:** A potluck luncheon was held for the baptism celebration on July 3<sup>rd</sup>. Another luncheon will be held on August 14<sup>th</sup> for 3 baptisms on that date. **Evangelism and Social Ministry:** Committee will collect items for the Food 2 Go 4 Kids program for a delivery on August 11, as well as collecting school supplies for the Westmoreland County Children's Bureau during the month of July. This information has been shared in the newsletter and weekly bulletins. **Finance:** No new information. **Property:** Will meet in August to discuss mower issues and prepare 2023 budget requests. We were able to remove a workbench and table from the mower room. Thank you to Bob and Mary Lou Wolff, who replaced the eternal candle with an electronic version, which will save on oil costs.

### **Ad Hoc Committees:**

**Cleaning Ad Hoc Committee:** Everything continues to go well. **Community Garden:** The garden is thriving! Fresh produce deliveries are being made to the Westmoreland County Food Bank. **Women of the ELCA:** The women will meet on Thursday, July 14.

### **Old Business:**

1. **Church Safety Policies and Procedures** - The Worship & Music Committee would like to ask Council if using homemade baked bread for Holy Communion would be permissible. If so, they will see if they can find someone willing to bake bread for this purpose. Council approved this request by consensus. In addition, as a reminder to the congregation, Fred Oestreicher will make an announcement to remind folks to ring the doorbell if the door is locked on Sunday mornings.
2. **Church Database software** – Council was asked to give permission for Pastor Paul and our Secretary Amy to update the website with a new web provider. Council offered their permission by consensus.
3. **2023 Budget Requests**

All committees are to submit their budget requests to the Finance Committee by the end of August. Any questions can be submitted to Eliot Moore, Financial Secretary. Worship & Music has submitted a request.

### 4. **Delivery of Semi Annual Financial Statements at the end of June**

Each year, we deliver a semi-annual financial statement to all those who have donated as a reminder of our

## New Business:

### 1. Requested CPR dates

WELCA will be contacted to see if that date is available for CPR, and Nation's Best CPR will be informed about all the requested dates.

### 2. Set date for Annual Meeting, Part 1

- (2) provide a proposed 2023 budget to vote on
- (3) conduct any other congregational business (none of which we are currently aware of)

The Annual Meeting, Part 1, can be held on the 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday in November. We usually hold it on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday, which would be **November 20<sup>th</sup>**.

Fred Oestreicher made a motion to set **November 20<sup>th</sup>** as the date for this year's annual congregational meeting, part 1.

Council President Fred Oestreicher called the meeting to Order at 8:03pm. Fred Oestreicher asked to add a new item under “New Business” titled “Riding Lawn Mower Fund”. Pastor Paul asked to add 2 new items under “New Business” titled “Electronic Drum Kit” and “Piano”. Fred Oestreicher made a motion to accept the Council agenda, as amended. Motion seconded by Bob Wolff. Motion carried. Fred Oestreicher made a motion to accept the minutes from the July 5 Council meeting, as presented. Motion seconded by Ryan Winslow. Motion carried. Eldora Crist, Treasurer, presented the July Treasurer’s report. Fred Oestreicher made a motion to accept the July Treasurer’s report. Motion seconded by Norb Georges. Motion carried. Pastor Paul presented his report for **July**. He attended the monthly Synod meeting for Pastors and Deacons. He led the Blessing of the Animals on the front lawn of the church on August 3<sup>rd</sup>. He made home visits with Chuck and Nancy Kemerer and with Barry Santavy. He presided at the funeral for a non-member. Pastor Paul continues to serve as Interim Pastor at Good Shepherd Lutheran Church in Greensburg for approximately 5 hours per week.

**Communications:** Received acknowledgments of the amount of produce delivered to the Westmoreland County Food Bank from the Community Garden at St. Matthias.

### **Committee Reports were presented:**

#### **Old Business:**

1. **Church Safety Policies and Procedures** – No updates needed at this time.
2. **Church Database software** – Pastor Paul, our church secretary Amy Repak, and Eliot Moore will look into pricing for new database software in 2023, so it can be included in the 2023 proposed budget. This item can be removed from the Council agenda.

#### 3. **2023 Budget Requests**

All committees are to submit their budget requests to the Finance Committee by the end of August. Any questions can be submitted to Eliot Moore, Financial Secretary. The Worship & Music and Property Committees have submitted requests.

#### 4. **Delivery of Semi Annual Financial Statements at the end of June**

Envelopes not picked up at the end of July were mailed out. This item can be removed from the Council agenda.

#### **New Business:**

##### 1. **Church Website**

Our church secretary, Amy Repak, has prepared an attachment to go over the details of her research for the costs and details of obtaining a new provider for web services for St. Matthias. The costs should be roughly the same (or possibly even a little lower) for the new platform. She’d like to receive Council’s approval to move forward with creating a new, more robust website, to no longer use FatCow, and to sign up for a new web provider. Council gave their consensus for Amy to move forward with this.

##### 2. **Riding Lawn Mower Fund**

On August 7<sup>th</sup>, the Property Committee decided to request to Council to create a “Riding Lawn Mower Fund”, which will go into the “Church Maintenance and Repair” with a goal amount of \$3,000, to purchase a new Riding Lawn Mower. We currently have 2 mowers which are used, and the one (the Cub Cadet) is failing. The committee has \$1,330 available from the Roof Fund, which was left over, and is available for Property equipment purchases. The anticipated cost is \$3,000, which leaves \$1,670 to be collected.

Fred Oestreicher made a motion to create a “Riding Lawn Mower Fund” with a goal amount of \$3,000 (with \$1,670 that still needs to be collected) to allow the Property Committee to purchase a new Riding Lawn Mower.

Motion seconded by Bob Wolff.

Motion carried.



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
